## **Wolfson gains public safety endorsements in re-election bid**

### ***Wolfson files for re-election today with police and fire fighters support***

LAS VEGAS—Las Vegas Councilman Steve Wolfson filed for re-election today carrying the early endorsements of the two major public safety organizations in Las Vegas—the Las Vegas Police Protective Association and the Las Vegas Fire Fighters Association.

“Public safety is always one of the top concerns in Ward 2,” Wolfson said, “and getting a vote of confidence from the police and fire fighters is a reflection of the partnership we’ve forged to respond to that concern.”

Dean Fletcher, President of the Las Vegas Fire Fighters, pointed out that Wolfson was part of the reason city fire fighters had a Class 1 rating reflecting the training, professionalism, and response time in dealing with calls. High ratings also are generally reflected in lower insurance premiums.

Executive Director of the Las Vegas Police Protective Association, Chris Collins, spoke of Wolfson’s dedication to the Las Vegas community. The reported crime rate in Ward 2 is consistently among the lowest according to the monthly analysis provided by the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department.

“I’m very proud to have the support of our public safety team,” Wolfson said, and I’m always reminded that we need to keep working and keep challenging ourselves to be even better.”
