## **Steve Wolfson Announces Plans to Run for Vacant City Seat**

*Long-time resident, attorney, father of two starts strong.*

Long time Las Vegas resident and attorney Steve Wolfson announced today he will file for election to the vacant Las Vegas City Council Ward 2 seat. Wolfson's announcement came immediately after the Las Vegas City Council outlined its plans for a special election.

Previously, the City Council had considered making an appointment as they have in the past. Wolfson, 49, submitted his application along with endorsements from the Las Vegas Police Protective Association, the Unity Council of Nevada, the Charleston Neighborhood Preservation Association, and the Downtown Central Development Committee.

"The endorsements I submitted reflect who I am, what type of campaign I plan to run, and how I would serve if elected," Wolfson said. "My concern for public safety is underlined by the police endorsement. My emphasis on neighborhoods is reflected by the support of one of the most established neighborhood groups. I believe in outreach, and I know the core of Las Vegas must develop or die and my endorsements support that."

Wolfson said the city's proposal for a special election "lets the people have a choice" although he recognizes that time is very short. "With the time allotted, I'm going to work as hard as I can to meet voters, discuss issues, and define my hopes for our future," Wolfson said. "I'm prepared and ready for this race."

Wolfson is celebrating his fiftieth birthday with his wife and two teenage daughters on Friday.
