Three Public Safety Groups Back Wolfson

City Council candidate Steve Wolfson earns backing from police, fire, and police civilian employees.

Steve Wolfson's campaign received a big boost as all three public safety employee groups endorsed his candidacy for Las Vegas City Council.

Today the Las Vegas Police Protective Association Civilian Employees announced they were joining the Las Vegas Police Protective Association and the Las Vegas Fire Fighters #1285 in supporting Wolfson. Terri Yada, head of the civilian employees political action committee said the committee, "believes in Steve Wolfson's dedication and commitment."

"I've emphasized the importance of public safety in this campaign," Wolfson said. "We can't maintain a decent quality of life without it. I'm grateful that the police officers, police civilian employees and our Las Vegas firefighters are behind me in this effort."
